For the following common infectious diseases, please refer to the attendance guidelines below, follow the advice of your doctor, and submit this form to the school upon your return.

Disease Name	Symptoms	Kindergarten Attendance Guidelines
Strep Throat	Fever, pharyngitis, vomiting, small rash appears on occasion.	24-48 hours after taking antibiotics.
Mycoplasma Pneumonia	Increasingly sever cough, fever, headache.	Fever and severe cough must be gone.
Hand Foot Mouth Disease	Blistering rash develops in the mouth, hands, and feet, severe mouth ulcers, sometimes unable to eat.	Ability to eat normally, no fever, oral blisters, or ulcers.
Erythemia (apple disease)	Redness of cheeks, erythema on limbs.	Must be in good general health.
Norovirus/Rotavirus	Nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, fever.	Vomiting, diarrhea, and other symptoms should subside and the patient should be able to eat food normally.
Herpangina	High fever, sore throat, blistering near the back of the throat.	Ability to eat a normally without the effects of fever, oral blisters, or ulcers.
RS Virus Infection	Fever, nasal discharge, cough, wheezing.	Respiratory symptoms must have resolved and the child must be in good general condition.
Shingles	Blister formation.	After all rashes have crusted over.
Roseola Infantum	High fever of 38 degrees Celsius or higher Appearance of a reddish-red rash centered on the torso.	Fever should be broken and the patient should be in a good general health.
Human Metapneumovirus (hMPV)	Fever, nasal discharge, cough, wheezing (breath sounds such as wheezing and hissing), dyspnea	Respiratory symptoms must have resolved and the patient must be in good general condition.
