Measels	Fever, loss of appetite, conjunctiva, white spots in the mouth the size of poppy seeds, all over rash after 2 to 3 days	3 days after being fever free.
German Measels	Rash over the entire body with a fever of around 38 degrees Celsius, swollen lymph nodes.	After the rash disappears.
Chicken Pox	Fever, red bumps on the face, limbs, and chest, rash also on scalp which later blisters.	After all rashes have healed.
Mumps	Fever, swelling under the earlobe.	Until 5 days after the swollen glands have gone down and your child is in good health.
Tuberculosis	Fever, cough, phlegm	Until a physician determines that there is no risk of infection.
Pharyngoconjunctival Fever (Pool Fever)	fever, pharyngitis, and conjunctivitis.	2 days after the main symptoms disappear.
Pink Eye	Swollen conjunctiva on the whites of the eyes and behind the eyelids, excessive eye discharge.	Because it is highly contagious, until the conjunctivitis symptoms have disappeared.
Whooping Cough	Violent coughing.	Until symptoms have disappeared or a 5 day antibiotic course has been completed.
Enterohemorrhagic Coliform Infection (O157, O26, O111, etc.)	Abdominal pain, dysentery, bloody stool.	Until symptoms have resolved, antibiotic treatment has been completed, and two consecutive stool samples taken 48 hours apart have both been confirmed negative for bacteria.
Acute Hemorrhagic Conjunctivitis	Acute conjunctivitis, conjunctival hemorrhaging.	Until a physician determines that there is no risk of infection.
Meningitis	High fever, nausea, rigidity of the neck, psychiatric symptoms	Until a physician determines that there is no risk of infection.
