May 5th is Children's Day, a special occasion to celebrate our children's growth and to wish for their continued health and happiness.

We decorate with koinobori (carp streamers), symbolizing strength and success. Traditional treats like kashiwa mochi (rice cakes wrapped in oak leaves) are also enjoyed. The oak leaves are a symbol of prosperity, as they don't fall until new buds appear—just like our hopes for a strong future for our children.

Chimaki (sweet rice dumplings wrapped in leaves) are also eaten on this day, as they are believed to protect against misfortune and bring good health.
